

Reminder for Incoming tourists to Kazakhstan 2024

Before departure please check your documents for travel:

- Passport
- Copy of your documents (may be useful in case of loss and in case of unforeseen circumstances);
- Air ticket;
- Voucher;
- Medical insurance

Attention! Conditions of stay on the territory of Kazakhstan in connection with COVID-19

According to the Resolution of the Chief State Sanitary Doctor of the Republic of Kazakhstan (hereinafter referred to as the RK) No. 27 dated 06/07/2022, from June 8, 2022, when entering Kazakhstan through all border crossing points the mandatory requirement for citizens of the RK and foreigners to present documentary evidence of vaccination or revaccination against COVID-19 (passports/ certificate/certificate of vaccination against COVID-19) was cancelled, and in their absence, a certificate with a negative result of a test for COVID-19 using the PCR method.

Visa

Foreign citizens and stateless persons to enter the territory of the RK need an entry and exit permit (hereinafter referred to as a visa), unless a different procedure is established by an international treaty of the RK. Visa of the RK - a mark of authorized state bodies of the RK in a migrant's passport or a document replacing it, or a mark of authorized state bodies of the Republic of Kazakhstan in an information system that gives the right to enter the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan, travel through its territory, stay on it and leave the territory Republic of Kazakhstan for the time, for the purposes and on the conditions established in the visa.

Unilateral visa-free regime

Foreigners from 54 countries do not require a visa to enter the RK. You can take advantage of the visa-free regime to visit Kazakhstan for tourism, guest and business purposes. Simplified visa-free entry allows you to freely stay and move throughout the country for 30 calendar days. To do this, it is enough to have a valid passport with you.

Important: the total period of stay in Kazakhstan should not exceed 90 calendar days during each 180-day period, but no more than 120 days within one calendar year. For a longer stay, we recommend applying for the appropriate visa.

A visa is not required for citizens of those countries with which Kazakhstan has ratified bilateral agreements on mutual visa-free travel.

For pregnant women

It is preferable for expectant mothers to arrive for the flight at the start of check-in.

Expectant mothers with a gestational age from 22 weeks to 34 weeks inclusive for a single pregnancy, and from 22 weeks to 32 weeks inclusive for a multiple pregnancy are transported if they have a certificate from a medical organization about the gestational age and satisfactory state of health. When departing from foreign airports, the certificate must be translated into a foreign language. The certificate is valid for 30 days.

If you have had complications during pregnancy, you should consult your doctor before traveling by air.

The airline refuses to transport pregnant women even with the conclusion of the medical advisory commission, form No. 026/u, if the due date is expected within the next 7 calendar days

Packing your luggage

We recommend that you put all valuables, documents and money in your hand luggage and take them with you on the plane. All metal sharp and cutting objects (nail scissors, nail files, penknife, etc.), as well as any liquids, gels and aerosols (except for baby food and medicines, if necessary) should be packed in your luggage - Carrying such items in hand luggage is prohibited. Don't forget to pack and take with you a first aid kit, which will help with minor ailments, save time searching for medicines and save you from unwanted communication in a foreign language.

At the airport of departure/arrival

Before leaving for the airport, obtain additional information about possible changes in departure conditions using the website of the airline operating the flight or by calling its help desk.

We recommend that you arrive at the passenger check-in point in advance, no later than three hours before departure, to go through the established check-in procedures, baggage check-in, and comply with the requirements related to border, customs, sanitary-quarantine, veterinary and other types of control established by the legislation of your country.

Customs control in Kazakhstan

The import and export of cash foreign and national currency, documentary securities and payment documents is carried out by residents and non-residents without restrictions, subject to the requirements of the customs legislation of the EAEU countries and the RK. Individuals have the right, without customs declaration, to import or export cash foreign and national currency (except for coins made of precious metals) and traveler's checks in a total amount equal to or not exceeding the equivalent of 10 thousand US dollars (about 4.2 million tenge). An amount exceeding the equivalent of 10 thousand US dollars is subject to mandatory customs declaration, with the exception of cases of



import or export carried out from or to the territory that is an integral part of the customs territory of the EAEU countries.

Foreign and national currency exported from the RK by non-residents is subject to written declaration.

Export from the Republic of Kazakhstan by non-resident individuals of cash foreign currency and payment documents, the nominal value (face value) of which is expressed in foreign currency, is carried out in accordance with the customs declaration drawn up by them upon import. In case of exceeding the amount specified in the customs declaration drawn up upon import, a written declaration of the export of foreign currency is carried out with the provision of documents confirming the legality of their origin, which may be:

1) certificates of purchase of foreign currency issued in the prescribed manner by exchange offices of authorized banks and authorized organizations carrying out certain types of banking operations;

2) documents confirming the withdrawal of money from a bank account in foreign currency, including the withdrawal of money from a card account, issued by authorized banks;

3) documents confirming the receipt of foreign currency through a one-time transfer, issued by authorized banks;

4) customs declaration on the amount of foreign currency previously imported into the Republic of Kazakhstan.

These documents must be submitted for the entire amount exported.

What can be imported to Kazakhstan?

Foreigners are allowed to import various types of goods into the territory of the republic without any restrictions and customs duties. Their total weight should not exceed 50 kilograms, and their total cost should not exceed the equivalent of 1 thousand dollars.

How many goods are allowed to be imported into Kazakhstan?

Each adult passenger has the right to freely transport 3 liters of alcoholic beverages. If you pay a customs fee of 10 euros per liter, you can add an additional 2 liters of alcohol. In total, no more than 5 liters per passenger.

The rules established by customs allow duty-free import of tobacco and other goods with the following restrictions:

- 1000 cigarettes or 15 cigars or 1 kilogram of tobacco,
- 100 liters of gasoline,
- 150 liters of diesel fuel.



It is prohibited to import the following goods into the territory of Kazakhstan:

- military-style weapons and ammunition, weapons of mass destruction, as well as equipment and materials that can be used to create such weapons;
- narcotic drugs, medications containing narcotic substances, psychotropic substances and precursors;
- visual and printed materials promoting war, aimed at terrorism, racism, violence, and undermining the state system;
- pornographic materials;
- soil, as well as living rooted plants with soil;
- all kinds of plant pathogens, which include cultures of living bacteria, viruses, fungi, as well as mites, insects, nematodes that damage plants;
- for quarantine products and products contaminated with quarantine organisms, seeds of quarantine weeds, with the exception of samples that are imported for scientific purposes and exclusively in agreement with the authorized body

The export ban applies to the following goods:

- military-style weapons, military equipment and ammunition, weapons of mass destruction;
- works of art, antiques, antiques and other types of items that represent significant artistic, cultural, scientific or historical value;
- gold, precious stones and rare minerals;
- rare specimens and collections of flora, as well as their parts and products obtained from them;
- are species of animals listed in the Red Book, as well as saiga horns;
- narcotic drugs, precursors and psychotropic substances;
- canceled securities;
- literature, photo and video products that contradict the norms of Islam or are aimed at undermining and discrediting public authorities of the Republic of Kazakhstan

Veterinary control/Transportation of animals

- Passengers traveling with pets must pre-agreed and book the service at least 24 hours before departure and should not bring their pets directly to the check-in counter;
- The possibility of transporting a pet in luggage or in the cabin of the aircraft complies with the current entry and exit rules of all countries relevant to your route;
- There is confirmation for transporting a pet in the cabin or cargo hold of all airlines on a direct, transit or transfer route;
- Necessary veterinary examinations or procedures (e.g. vaccinations, microchipping) have been completed sufficiently in advance of your travel;
- The official and veterinary documents necessary for your pet have been prepared (for example, an animal passport);



- Make sure you can take your pet with you in the cabin or cargo hold on all other airlines participating in your journey;
- The pet is clean and in good condition for transportation;
- Make sure you purchase an appropriately sized pet carrier that meets pet carrier requirements, including:
 - the ability for the pet to sit, stand, turn around and lie down in a natural position;
 - availability of suitable absorbent material;
 - presence of a half-filled water container in case of long-term transportation (more than 12 hours);
 - the ability of the container to pass air from all sides and the presence of ventilation holes of sufficient size (on four sides, 16% of the total surface area of the four sides of the container).
- We recommend making sure your pet is familiar with the shipping container. To keep the animal calm, we recommend placing bedding or a toy familiar to the pet in the container;
- Make sure your pet is wearing a collar or harness and has a suitable leash.

Required documents: Veterinary passport; Veterinary certificate; Microchip or tattoo to identify the animal.

The Republic of Kazakhstan

It ranks ninth in the world in terms of country area. 2,724,902 square kilometers! It borders in the north and west with Russia (border length - 7548.1 km), in the east - with China (1782.8 km), in the south - with Kyrgyzstan (1241.6 km), Uzbekistan (2351.4 km) and Turkmenistan (426 km). It is the largest landlocked country in the world. At the same time, it is washed by the inland waters of the Caspian and Aral seas

Administratively, the country is divided into 17 regions and three cities of republican significance, Astana, Almaty and Shymkent. In addition, there is a city with a special status, Baikonur, which is leased by Russia until 2050. Near the city there is a cosmodrome of the same name, which, by the way, is accessible to tourists.

Kazakhstan is a unitary state with a presidential form of government, establishing itself as a democratic, secular, legal and social state, the highest values of which are the person, his life, rights and freedoms.

The head of state is the President – Kassym-Jomart Kemelevich Tokayev. Executive power is exercised by the Government, consisting of ministries, services and agencies; legislative - parliament, consisting of two chambers - the Senate and the Mazhilis.

The capital of the Republic of Kazakhstan is the city of Astana. It is located in the northern part of the country on the Ishim River. On the left bank of Ishim stands the symbol of the capital - the modern



monument "Baiterek" 97 meters high. The observation deck of the tower offers a picturesque panoramic view of the city. In June 2017, the capital of Kazakhstan acquired the status of a million-plus city. The basis of its economy is: trade, transport and communications, construction. Baiterek is the main symbol of Astana and one of the main attractions of Kazakhstan.

Time

Time in Astana is +5 UTC.

On the night of February 29, 2024 to March 1, 2024 (at 00:00 hours), local time is moved back 1 hour in the cities: Astana, Almaty, Shymkent and in the regions: Akmola, Almaty, Zhambyl, Karaganda, Kostanay, Pavlodar, North Kazakhstan, Turkestan, East Kazakhstan and Abay, Zhetisu, Ulytau regions

Thus, the 5th time zone applies to the entire territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan

Climate

The remoteness from the oceans and the large territory of the country affect its climatic conditions, so the nature of Kazakhstan is striking in its contrasts. The climate of Kazakhstan (except for the south) is sharply continental with average temperatures between -4°C and -19°C in January and between +19...+26°C in July. In winter, temperatures can drop to -45°C, and in summer they can rise to +30°C. All four seasons of the year are clearly expressed on the territory of the country - with a frosty winter, a blooming spring, a hot summer and a golden autumn.

Currency

The national currency of Kazakhstan is the Kazakhstani tenge (code KZT).

Therefore, it is better to take care of exchanging cash in advance. Russian rubles, US dollars, euros, as well as other major currencies can be exchanged at banks and official exchange offices. In large cities, exchange offices where you can find out the exchange rate in Kazakhstan operate around the clock, and there are also quite a large number of ATMs. Bank cards (Visa, Master Card, Euro Card) are accepted for payment in the vast majority of shopping centers and hotels. However, if you plan to travel outside the cities, you will simply need cash in tenge.

Language

The official language of Kazakhstan is Kazakh. In state organizations and local government bodies, Russian is officially used along with Kazakh. The modern population speaks English, Turkish, Chinese and other languages.



Population

From the bureau's information it follows that the population of Kazakhstan as of December 1, 2023 was 20,014,575 people

Religion

The country's constitution defines the RK as a secular state. Most of the population of Kazakhstan are believers. Religious affiliation of the population of Kazakhstan based on the results of the 2009 and 2021 censuses (*according to Wikipedia data*) *Religion in Kazakhstan, 2021:*

Custom

Kazakhs are an eastern people with very strong traditions of hospitality. Any guest, even an uninvited one, should be received with respect, offered food and the best place in the yurt. It was customary to give a shapan (robe) to guests of honor, and this tradition has been preserved to this day. The traditions of hospitality in Kazakhstan have many details that receive great attention.

An important place in the upbringing of a young Kazakh is occupied by teaching him the principles of respect and reverence for his family, his ancestors and simply for his elders. It is significant that almost every Kazakh family greatly values genealogical records about their family tree, which often spans at least 30 generations. It is necessary to carefully preserve family heirlooms and items belonging to ancestors (such as clothes, saddles, jewelry).

Most often, Kazakhs do not show aggression; their main guidelines are peace and tolerance. Perhaps it is precisely this national feature that explains the absence of significant clashes on national or religious grounds in Kazakh history.



Residents of Kazakhstan pay great attention to relationships with the people around them and do not have a desire for individualism. For example, it is appropriate to invite new neighbors to visit in order to establish good relations. The opinions of other people matter to a Kazakh. And those who occupy leadership positions in society should be especially attentive to the people's point of view. Any leader must first of all think about the well-being of his subordinates and respect them.

Cuisine

Main courses are meat. Among them, a special place is occupied by the most common dish, called *et* in Kazakh, which means meat itself in translation. Russian names of dishes are Kazakh meat, *beshbarmak* (cf. Kazakh *besbarmak*). Also popular are *kuurdak* (fried pieces of liver, leaves, lungs, heart, intestines, etc. with potatoes), *buktyрма*, *kespe* (noodles), *sorpa* (meat broth), *ak-sorpa* (milk soup with meat, or just meat soup). with *kurt*, "sirne" (cooked or in a cauldron, fried young lamb with onions and potatoes) and "palau" (Kazakh pilaf with a lot of meat), *naryn* (meat broth soup and dough from *besbarmak* or homemade noodles with *kurut*), pies of the cities and caravanserais of the Silk Road - *samsa*, both the widespread triangular and fried *buyrek* "kidneys" (they are also in the south of *Bükteme*). The main dishes usually also include a variety of different sausages: *kazy* (sausage made from horse meat, depending on the level of fat content), *karta*, *shuzhyk*, as well as a special part of horse meat - *zhal*. Dried and smoked meats are also used in the kitchen and are understandably common in rural areas.

Kazakh cuisine has changed recently. More borrowings have appeared in the national cuisine. Against the background of modern Kazakh, in addition to the traditional, dishes of Eastern European nationalities, such as Ukrainian, Russian, Belarusian and even German families, are often found. Also, many dishes were borrowed from the cuisine of the eastern peoples inhabiting Kazakhstan, such as dishes of the Caucasian peoples, Dungan, Uzbek, Uyghur, Bashkir, Tatar, Korean, etc. Typical dishes at Kazakh celebrations and events in addition to the obligatory traditional dishes: *lagmans*, *shashlik*, *samsa*, boiled and fried dumplings, pickles and marinades, smoked meat products, vegetable, fruit and meat salads, dessert products such as cakes, pastries, candies, ice cream, marmalade. and so on have long become a common diet.

The first day of Kurban Ait, celebrated according to the Muslim calendar, January 7 - Orthodox Christmas are days off. In 2024, the first day of Kurban Ait falls on June 17.

In a hotel

Within three working days after the traveler enters Kazakhstan, the receiving party must submit notification of the foreigner's arrival. This is what the hotel does:

-Through the eQonaq information system.

On the day of arrival, check-in is carried out in accordance with the rules adopted at the hotel. Usually starting at 14:00 local time. Please familiarize yourself with the terms and conditions of the hotel's services on site and adhere to the rules established by the hotel.

On the day of departure, before check-out time (usually 12:00), you must vacate your room and pay for additional services: telephone calls, mini-bar, ordering food and drinks in your room, massage, etc. You can leave your luggage in the hotel storage room and remain on the hotel premises until the transfer arrives. If you have not checked out the room before 12:00, the cost of the room is paid in full for the next day.

On the abolition of the tour tax (bed tax) for foreign tourists to Kazakhstan. Now foreign tourists will not pay tax for staying in the country. *“By Order of the Minister of Tourism and Sports of RK, according to which a zero rate will apply throughout the territory of Kazakhstan. The changes will come into effect on January 9 of this year, 2024.”*

Mobile operators

Almost the entire territory of Kazakhstan is within the coverage area of mobile communications. The main mobile operators in Kazakhstan: Kcell, Beeline, Tele2, Altel4G. There is no fundamental difference in which one to use if you are going to travel near cities and large settlements.

Buy SIM cards, perhaps even in shops along the road. But at the main points of sale at international airports, train stations, and shopping centers, there will be more choice, as well as a greater chance that the seller speaks English and, most importantly, you will be able to help with everything!

Required list of documents for registering numbers/drawing out an agreement with a subscriber:
Individual – non-resident of the RK: passport.

Transport infrastructure

The transport infrastructure in Kazakhstan is quite well developed. The country has 20 major airports, of which 11 serve transportation. However, the main mode of transport for transporting passengers and goods is trains. The length of railways in Kazakhstan is 15000. km. 16 junction points connect the



railway network of Kazakhstan with neighboring countries - 11 with the country, two with Uzbekistan, one with Kyrgyzstan, two with China. To date, passengers have been transported on 116 routes. Also in Kazakhstan, transport is well developed, designed to transport the population according to a specific schedule and route. Shuttle buses run in all cities, and in some cities there are tram depots. There is a metro in Almaty. You can also use a taxi call service, or rent a car for self-driving. Bicycles are quite popular in the summer. In large cities there are special points where you can rent them. For tourists observing in a small group, it is beneficial to use a taxi in Kazakhstan. The taxi service is also suitable for travel in different cities. A large number of cars with checkers on the roof are always near airports, metro stations and bus stops. You can also find taxis near shopping centers and markets.

Types of Sockets in Kazakhstan In Kazakhstan, sockets of the European standard (type C, E, F) with a voltage of 220 Volts 50 Hertz are used

Excursions The guide/tour guide/translator/representative in Kazakhstan of Anex Tour Kazakhstan, during the meeting at the airport/hotel, will provide a list of offered excursions, their content, schedule and cost. We do not recommend purchasing excursions or other services from travel and excursion agencies unknown to you. You may be given deliberately false information about the excursion itself, as well as about the quality of transport for its organization. You may be provided with uncertified, defective, or unhygienic equipment for use.

Shopping Clothing and footwear: The national clothing of the Kazakhs is the fur coat "Kaptal", the homespun caftan "Chekmen", the quilted robe "Chapan", the sleeveless vest "Kupi" ("Buy") , cloak "Kobenek" ("Kobenek"), trousers "Shalbansyr" ("Shalbansyr") and camisole. The women's outfit is a long dress with a wide hem "Kulish Kojlek", an open women's jacket with a wide peplum "Kazakin", a vest and pants. A Muslim woman's head is covered with a scarf - for a married woman it is "Zhaulyk" ("Zhaulyk"), for an unmarried woman it is "Kimeshek" ("Kimeshek"). Men prefer to wear skullcaps in any weather, although you can choose a good alternative: "Borik" ("Borik") - embroidered with gold



“Altyn Borik” (“Altyn Borik”), decorated with pearls “Kalmarzhan Borik” (“Kalmarzhan Borik”) or bordered with beaver and marten skins “Kamshat Borik” (“Kamshat Borik”). Traditional shoes are considered to be light boots with a soft toe and an internal hard heel “Igichi”.

The Almaty tannery provides the country not only with shoes, but also with bags, backpacks, wallets, purses, belts, belts, prayer rugs “Namazlyki” (“Namazlyki”)

There are also unusual things - leather pendants with quotes from the Holy Koran “Tumary” (“Tumary”) and leather flasks for kumys / ayran / shubat and water “Saba”. When making koumiss vessels, preference is given to horse skins, as they are durable and waterproof. Dishes made from camel skin are also valued for these properties. The bottle-shaped vessel “Botlok” (“Botlok”) is best made from the skin of a horse’s hind legs; flasks of a unique shape are sewn from the skin of the front legs, preserving the knee protrusions “Kullyk” (“Kullyk”), from the skin removed from the horse’s head without longitudinal cuts, “Bashkunek” milk bowls are made, “Korege” vats are made from neck skin. There are also containers from the heart sac, peritoneum, and large intestines. For sour cream, vessels from the udder of a cow “Kuzege” are used, and leather churns are called “Bot Kunek”. Flat flasks “Tursuki” (“Tursuki”) with a narrow neck and a hair loop are convenient to take with you on a hike, tied to the saddle. A huge assortment of leather tableware is presented at city bazaars.

The pottery craft of Kazakhstan has long been a source of national pride.

We advise you to take one of the Kazakh sets with you, so that every tea party will remind you of oriental generosity. Instead of a set, you can pick up several traditional “Kosushki” bowls. These containers are considered one of the unofficial symbols of the country. You may need a dish for serving beshbarmak “Astau” or a vat for pilaf “Kazan”. Such dishes will serve you for many years, and they are inexpensive. Look for utensils for table setting in hypermarkets across the country: “China Shop” and “Tarelochka”

Textiles in the “Corpe” style. How about the “Zher Korpe” floor cover, the “Zhamylgy Korpe” blanket, the “Oyu Korpe” patterned blanket, the “Ku Korpe” goose down mattress (“Ku Korpe”) or the carpet for honored guests “Tor Korpe” (“Tor Korpe”)? In Kazakhstan you will be able to buy unique home textiles using the Kurak Korpe patchwork technique. It is difficult to imagine a house in Kazakhstan without a building.

Kazakh silver. Jewelry art occupies a special place in the history of Kazakh national culture, and jewelry plays an important role. Silver is famous in Kazakhstan. There are so many interesting things you can do with this metal. There are jewelry that can be classified as Muslim and national. These are, for example, “Sholpy” coin earrings, “Tarmaksha” chest jewelry, “Bilezik” wide bracelets, “Ajsyrga” crescent earrings, round bracelets “Zhumyr” (“Zhumyr”), jewelry for braids “Sholpy” (“Sholpy”), pendants for a wedding headdress “Saukelenin Syrgasa” (“Saukelenin Syrgasa”) and other little things. We recommend purchasing edible souvenirs at local markets.

Fruits and vegetables are definitely worth buying at the markets. Here they are the most aromatic, tasty and juicy. Take plums, peaches, pears, apples, watermelons, melons, oranges, kiwis or other fruits. Right there in the same fruit display you will find dried fruits and nuts.



The most useful gift is considered to be camel thorn honey. A less medicinal product is local condensed milk.

Oriental sweets are sold in sets in beautiful packaging. Do not deny yourself the pleasure of enjoying chocolate and marmalade from Kazakh companies “Lotte Rahat” and “Bayan Sulu”. We also include dried balls of suzma, spices and herbs “Kurt” as a snack. Horse meat sausages. It can be “Kazy” (“Kazy”) or “Shuzhuk” (“Shuzhuk”). For drinks, we recommend fermented milk ayran, tan, shubat and kumis. This is the most popular soft drink in Kazakhstan. Drinks differ in alcohol content, thickness and salty taste.
